This member category enables long-term members who have retired to stay in touch with their former colleagues and profession. Retired members retain all member benefits at a 50 percent savings on APICS corporate dues.

+ +Chapter dues allocated are at the discretion of the chapter president.

To be eligible for retired member status you must

- ✓ Be retired from formal employment
- ✓ Have been an APICS member at least five years, not necessarily consecutively
- ✓ Be 62 years of age or older

If you wish to apply for retired member status, submit this form to your chapter president with your membership renewal notice. Make sure you include payment for APICS corporate dues and chapter dues if applicable when you submit the form.

Retired Member Benefit Rules

1. RETIRED MEMBERS QUALIFICATIONS

- a. Retired from formal employment
- b. An APICS member at least five years, not necessarily consecutively
- c. 62 years of age or older

2. APPLICATION/VERIFICATION PROCESS

- a. The member will apply in writing to his/her chapter president and include a copy of the APICS billing notice. (If you are the chapter president requesting the extension, the signature of another chapter officer is required as approval).
- b. Each chapter will determine its own method for verifying.
- c. Authorization will be in the form of a letter (or form #82004) to APICS District and Chapter Services from the chapter president or a designated chapter officer. It will include a statement of authority and the member's name and membership number and be accompanied by a copy of the member's billing notice and payment.

3. TIMING

- a. All statements of authority must reach APICS within 30 days after the membership expiration date.

4. RETIRED MEMBER PRIVILEGES

- a. Voting privileges in society elections
- b. Able to hold office
- c. Discount on publications, programs, and materials
- d. Receive magazine, *APICS Magazine*
- e. Receive the APICS Dictionary and access to the conference proceedings, if requested

APICS Corporate will bill each member on his/her anniversary month. The billing will include both APICS corporate and chapter dues. APICS Corporate dues will be reduced by 50 percent of regular association dues. Each chapter president will be responsible for assessing the chapter dues amount the member will pay. Payment is due within 30 days after billing. The retired member will apply for this benefit through the local chapter.
